### **Rejuvenating and restoring India's lakes and water bodies: Enzen Water Solutions sign a MoU with France based Tech Sub post the EBTC environment mission held in Bengaluru.**

The restoration of water bodies requires a sound knowledge of the environment and the ecosystem. This project will bring together all of the required skills to rehabilitate water bodies, ensuring complete, effective and long lasting solutions. The best practices will help in conceptualizing and designing some of the excellent concepts for a better ecosystem approach in future.
